## **VENUE RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

- Camping allowed in designated camping areas only.
- A designated disabled person's camping block is available.
- Regrettably no camping sites may be reserved.
- Urinals & temporary chemical toilets will be available. Bring your own toilet paper.
- The vendor area, where basic takeaways can be purchased, is located near the stage.
- Please do not park in front of gates.
- Emergency Services: Medical staff will be on duty. An ambulance will be on standby.
- Terrain water is safe for washing only, bring your own fresh drinking water or purchase bottled water from the vendor area.
- Observe TOTAL silence from 11pm to 5am. Please respect and obey this rule.

## **PROHIBITED**

- NO open fires in the camping area (including a weber). ONLY Gas cooking equipment may be used within the camping areas.
- Open fires are only allowed in the COMMUNAL BRAAI AREA.
- NO Alcohol, NO Drugs, NO Weapons.
- NO MOTORBIKES other than arrival & parking.
- NO QUAD BIKES other than MMC officials.
- NO DRONES.
- No VENDORS unless approved by MMC.
- NO PARKING IN FRONT OF DESIGNATED AREAS and GATES.
- NO LADIES ALLOWED until Sunday at time stipulated on program.
- NO VEHICLES ALLOWED on the hill towards or near the cross.
- We regret that no pets are allowed.

## GENERAL INFO

- It is very important to note that our venue is a working farm. Although we spray for ticks each year, there remains a risk of tickbites. Please remember to
